The program provides a range of subsidised services to ventures & ambitious entrepreneurs, empowering them to propel their ideas towards successful commercialisation.

Support on Offer

The program is offering subsidised access to: incubators, coaching, mentoring, office space, networks, memberships, legal and accounting services or any other appropriate services identified during the assessment phase.

Ventures will be asked to contribute a maximum 10% of the total cost of services received and will receive a complementary ticket to Freo Start Up Fest

Process for Applicants

- **Submit Expression of Interest:** via www.propelfremantle.com.au
- **Assessment phase:** Ventures will be assessed and referred – some will be offered subsidised services
- **Services:** Will be recommended from a selection of pre-approved providers
- **Evaluation and feedback:** Ventures provide evaluation on your progress and review the program

Eligibility Criteria

- WA based founders and entrepreneurs (ventures will be offered a chance to work from Fremantle)
- Ventures/Ideas must be related to one of three focus sectors: Marine, Sustainability or Immersive Technology
- Applicants must be willing to undertake an evaluation process up to 3 months after the services have been received

Can NFP's apply?

As long as your venture is in one of our focus sectors you can apply

Will everyone be accepted?

Not all applicants will receive access to subsidised services but all will be given recommendations based on their needs

Do I have to be in Fremantle?

No, we will be offering access to space in Fremantle but it is not a requirement
