- **Assessment phase:** Ventures will be assessed and referred – some will be offered subsidised services
- **Services:** Will be recommended from a selection of pre-approved providers
- **Evaluation and feedback:** Ventures provide evaluation on your progress and review the program

PROPEL FREMANTLE PROGRAM

The program provides a range of subsidised services to ventures & ambitious entrepreneurs, empowering them to propel their ideas towards successful commercialisation.

Eligibility Criteria

- Ventures must either be looking to operate within the Blue Economy, Immersive Technology or Sustainability
- Don't need to be working in Fremantle but understand that co-working space will be in Fremantle
- There are no barriers for early stage ventures to apply
- Must be willing to obtain an ABN
- Applicants must be willing to undertake an evaluation process up to 6 months after the services have been received

Will everyone be accepted?

Not all applicants will receive access to subsidised services but all will be given recommendations based on their needs

Do I have to be in Fremantle?
