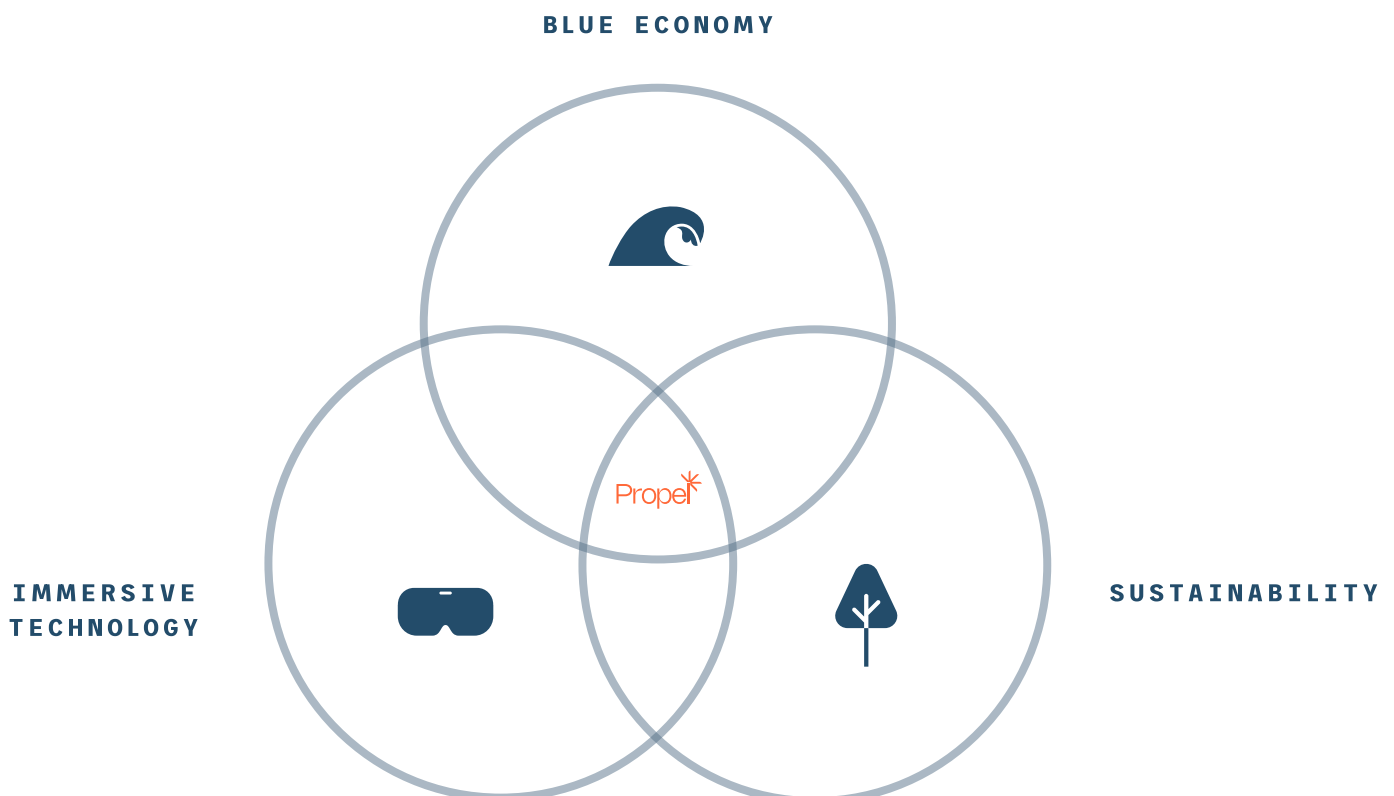
What is Propel Fremantle?

Fremantle has long held a reputation for providing an irresistible milieu for Australia's most creative and talented people, and Fremantle seeks to raise the profile of the thriving start-up and innovation ecosystem that exists within our unique and elective heritage streets.

The Propel Fremantle initiative aims to boost innovation in Fremantle by leveraging its expertise, creative community, and cultural heritage. It seeks to unite various resources like events, accelerators, and incubators to empower entrepreneurs and businesses.

With an eye on future changes, especially the potential relocation of Fremantle Port, the initiative focuses on nurturing growth in key sectors: the blue economy, sustainability, and immersive technology. This initiative connects entrepreneurs with opportunities across various sectors to foster job creation and economic growth in Fremantle.





THE BLUE ECONOMY - THE FOUNDATION

Currently supporting approximately 1,400 jobs within the City of Fremantle, marine based industries are a significant contributor to the City's local economy and a strong foundation upon which to grow Fremantle's innovation capabilities and unique knowhow.



SUSTAINABILITY - A CORE VALUE AND FOCUS FOR INNOVATION

Fremantle is home to a diverse and growing local sustainability sector which includes retailers, manufacturing, tech start-ups, consultancies, research groups, hospitality, technology and space providers with a shared vision and purpose around producing services and products that are specifically focused on promoting and innovating sustainability, environment, and circular economy solutions.



IMMERSIVE & CREATIVE TECHNOLOGIES - SUPPORTING BLUE INNOVATION

Currently supporting approximately 550 diverse jobs within the City of Fremantle, the creative industries, (including performing arts, music and sound recording, video production and distribution and knowledge-based industries such as architecture, design, gaming, and digital technologies continue) underpin the City's vibrancy, strong sense of community and progressive identity.

Propel Fremantle Accelerator Fund

The City of Fremantle in consultation with the Propel Fremantle ecosystem partners developed the Propel Fremantle Accelerator Fund, identified as just one program designed to assist the Propel initiative with the objective of identifying and supporting early-stage ventures

Coordinated by Ecosystem Partners and funded by Spacecubed, Lotterywest's Innovative Society Initiative, and City of Fremantle, the program provides resources such as co-working spaces, legal consulting, and market analysis for up to ten ventures that sit within three of Fremantle's growth sectors of Blue Economy, Sustainability, and Immersive and Creative Technology.

Through an expression of interest process and diagnosis phase, the program aims to prepare ventures for formal accelerator programs, offering exposure to Fremantle's innovation landscape and opportunities to participate in events like Freo Start Up Fest.

Successful applicants receive access to world leading expert advice, referrals, and feedback from the Ecosystem Partners.

In 2023, the inaugural program selected nine ventures which were offered a share of a total \$50,000 grant accessing business coaching, mentoring, access to co-working memberships, legal and accounting services and other support that was identified during an assessment phase managed by Propel partners.

Ventures from the 2023 Propel Fremantle Accelerator Fund have subsequently succeeded in securing additional grants.



2023 Recipients

Anelo, an EV charging platform that gives users centralised information on charging availability, type and accessibility.

Conifir Technologies, a carbon emission tracking platform leveraging AI to extract and classify information, offering visualised insights to help clients track their emissions in near real time.

Freo Creative, a creative studio with an extensive network of collaborators delivering 3D, VR and AR projects to a broad target market ranging from government agencies to resource companies.

How I Started, a membership organisation dedicated to providing education, planning, career development and coaching for aspiring or current screen professionals.

Kelp Island, a marine venture committed to decarbonising the global construction sector with its innovative Sea Brick – made of seaweed that is stronger than concrete.

Ludic Learning Lab, a healthcare tool providing medical professionals with creative learning solutions using XR technology and wellness training.

Mantle Marine, a new marine brokerage business leveraging established relationships to connect vessel owners, construction companies and international clients.

Over 3 Oceans, a marine tech dashboard that measures a vessel's weight in water to assist with safety and cargo management, primarily aimed at bulk cargo carriers and defence.

Sensorium D-Lite, a venture deploying XR and other immersive tech to work with small and medium- sized enterprises in Australia, USA and the UK that are engaged with AUKUS pillar 2 initiatives.
